Monday: "What we've got here is a failure to communicate." -Captain (from Cool Hand Luke). Communication can be difficult sometimes can't it?! From assuming to just blatant disregard...misinterpretation to no communication at all, a 'failure to communicate' causes issues in our marriages, our jobs, our families, or churches. Beginning this coming Sunday we will be communicating the concept of developing faithfulness. As we have looked at the faithfulness of God we now dig in to the need of being faithful in several areas ourselves. Pray for us. Pray for our leadership, our minister, our country, our church, our communities, our neighbors. Pray we communicate the goodness and need of God clearly. God, help us be the good needed.
