Made For More (Josh Baldwin)

Monday: In Colossians 3:12-14 we see how as God's chosen people... you need to clothe yourself with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Every day, we choose what we wear. We can put on frustration... or we can put on Jesus. Mission-minded followers know kindness is love in action. We've been covered in God's mercy, so we should wrap others in it too. At home, at work, everywhere, wear kindness well. Let people feel Jesus when you show up. Lord, clothe me in compassion and kindness today so others may see You through me. Keep me invisible so they see You. In Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: The Good Samaritan in Luke 10 didn't just feel bad...he did good. Compassion noticed, stopped, helped, and gave. Mission-minded people don't just talk about love... they live it. Kindness often costs time, comfort, and convenience, but that's exactly what Jesus did for us. Who around you is hurting today? Don't just walk by. Be the hands of Jesus. Compassion is often as simple as stopping for the wounded. Lord, open my eyes to those who need love today and move me to act with compassion. In Jesus' name, amen.

Wednesday: Jesus reminds us how deeply we've been forgiven in Matthew 18, so how can we withhold grace from others? Compassion grows when we remember the mercy we've received. Kindness means forgiving, being patient, and choosing humility over pride. Mission-minded followers don't keep score because Jesus didn't keep score with us. Freely forgiven people should freely forgive. Somebody needs grace from you today. Give it freely as it's been freely given to you. Lord, help me remember how much You've forgiven me so I may show patience, mercy, and kindness to others. Through Jesus I pray, amen.

Thursday: Jesus said the world would know we belong to Him by our love. Not by words alone but by action. Real disciples love deeply, serve humbly, and care compassionately. How we treat people matters. Mission-minded living means showing Jesus through kindness, even when it's hard. Love the overlooked. Encourage the hurting. Serve the inconvenient. Let your actions preach Jesus before your mouth ever does. Father, teach me to love others so clearly that people see You in me. I need to do more. In Jesus name, amen.

Friday: Jesus calls us to be salt and light. Salt changes what it touches. Light changes what it enters. Kindness works the same way. A kind word, helping hand, or simple encouragement can shift someone's whole day. Mission-minded followers bring hope where there's hurt. The world has enough darkness, so be light. The world has enough bitterness, so be kindness. You may be someone's reminder that God still cares. God, make me salt and light today, bringing compassion, hope, and kindness as I go. In Jesus, amen.

Saturday: We become compassionate by remembering the compassion we've received. God found us broken and loved us anyway. He forgave us, restored us, and never gave up on us. When we remember that mercy our hearts soften toward others. Mission-minded kindness begins with gratitude for God's grace. Somebody needs the same patience today that God gave you yesterday. So love freely. Forgive quickly. Show compassion boldly. Good God Almighty, keep me mindful of Your mercy so I may reflect that same compassion to others. Explode KCC in mighty ways as we strive to be the good through Jesus, amen.
