Communion Meditation & Closing Prayer: Derrick Hall

Monday: Paul asked believers to devote themselves to prayer and pray that God would open doors for the message (Colossians 4:2-4). Before we can share the Good News, we gotta seek the One who saves. A missions-minded heart begins on its knees. Pray for opportunities. Pray for courage. Pray for open hearts. God is still opening doors today. The question is whether we're watching and ready to walk through them when they appear. Father, open doors for the Gospel and help me faithfully walk through them. In Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: Sometimes we make sharing Jesus more complicated than it needs to be. The Gospel is simple. We sinned. Jesus died. Jesus rose. Jesus saves. Romans 3:21-26 reminds us that we are justified by God's grace through faith in Christ. People need to hear that hope, learn, love, live that message, and then share it clearly and confidently. The most powerful Gospel conversations are often the simplest and most sincere. Lord, help me communicate Your truth clearly and faithfully with all I come in contact with. In Jesus name, amen.

Wednesday: Ephesians 2 reminds us how we were once dead in sin and separated from God. Then comes the wonderful reminder: "But God...". Missions-minded people never forget where they came from. When we remember the grace we've received, we become more patient and compassionate toward those who are still searching. Never look down on someone who is lost. Remember that someone once cared enough to tell you about Jesus and point you toward hope. Father, help me extend the same grace to others that You have shown me. In the perfect name of Jesus, amen.

Thursday: You may not know every Bible answer, but you know what Jesus has done for you. Titus 3:3-8 reminds us that God's kindness and mercy changed our lives. People can debate facts and opinions, but a changed life speaks loudly. Your testimony may be the bridge God uses to reach someone else. Don't underestimate the power of sharing how Christ forgave, restored, and transformed you. Someone needs to hear your story. Lord, give me courage to share what You have done in my life. Through Jesus name, amen.

Friday: When God opens a door, we need to be ready to speak. Paul prayed not only for opportunities but also for clarity in sharing Christ (Colossians 4:3-4). We need to do the same. Prepare yourself by learning the Gospel and practicing how to share it, then trust God with the results. Faithfulness is not having every answer. Faithfulness is being willing to speak when God provides the opportunity and trusting Him to work through your words. Father, help me speak clearly and boldly when opportunities arise. I need You. In Jesus, amen.

Saturday: A missions-minded life is not a one-time event; it's a daily commitment. Every conversation, every act of kindness, every invitation, and every prayer can become an opportunity to point someone toward Jesus. Lost people matter deeply to God, so they should matter deeply to us! We have got to remain devoted to prayer, faithful to the Gospel, and committed to sharing Christ wherever He places us. Stay focused on the mission and trust God to provide the opportunities. They're all around us if we'll only pay attention. Lord, keep my heart focused on Your mission and Your people. In Jesus, amen.
