Communion Meditation & Closing Prayer: Glenn Bagley

Monday: Jesus looked at ordinary fishermen and said, "Follow me, and I will make you fish for people" (Matthew 4:19). He didn't call them because they were experts...He called them because they were willing. Same goes today. Every follower of Christ has a role in reaching others. You do not need all the answers...you simply need a willing heart to follow where Jesus leads. The greatest catch often begins with a simple act of obedience. Father, help me follow Jesus faithfully and become a fisher of people for You. In Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: Fishing requires patience. Rarely does a fisherman cast one line and immediately fill the boat. Sharing Jesus can be much the same. Some people need time to see Christ in us, hear the gospel, and consider His invitation. Our responsibility is not to force results but to remain faithful. Keep praying. Keep loving. Keep sharing. God is often working beneath the surface long before we see evidence of it. Trust Him with the outcome. Good God Almighty, give me patience and faith as I seek to point others to Jesus. In His name I pray, amen.

Wednesday: Before Jesus returned to heaven, He gave His followers a mission: GO! "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). This command was not only for pastors, missionaries, or church leaders. It was given to every person who claims Jesus as Savior. Wherever God has placed you is a mission field. At work, school, in your neighborhood, and among your family and friends, opportunities exist to share the hope of Christ. The mission continues until Jesus returns. Father, open my eyes to the mission field around me and help me serve faithfully. In Jesus' name, amen.

Thursday: Jesus didn't call us merely to make converts; He called us to make disciples. A fisherman does more than catch fish—he teaches others where and how to fish. The same principle applies spiritually. As we help folks **come** to Christ, we should also help them **grow** in Christ. Encourage them, study with them, pray with them, and walk beside them. Healthy followers become follower-makers who continue the work of the kingdom. Lord, help me invest in others so they can grow into faithful disciples of Jesus. In Jesus name, amen.

Friday: In Acts 1:8, Jesus promised His followers power through the Holy Spirit so they could be His witnesses. The mission was never meant to be accomplished by human strength alone. Sometimes fear, uncertainty, or feelings of inadequacy keep us silent. Remember that God never asks us to go alone. The Holy Spirit equips, strengthens, and guides us. Trust His presence. He can use even simple conversations to change a life forever. Father, help me rely on Your Spirit and boldly share the good news of salvation. In Jesus, amen.

Saturday: Every soul matters to God. Behind every face is a person loved by Christ and in need of salvation. As this series comes to a close tomorrow, remember that the mission continues. Jesus is still calling His followers to go fishing. Someone near you needs encouragement, truth, forgiveness, and hope. Cast the net. Share your story. Invite them to know. The greatest joy is seeing someone move from lost to found through the grace of God. Father, give me a heart for lost souls and the courage to reach them. In Jesus name, amen.
