## **KCC Daily Devotion**

**Monday:** (Mark 13:1–8) The disciples were impressed with the temple stones. Jesus wasn't. He saw what they couldn't see (that it would all come down). What feels permanent to us isn't permanent to Him. Wars, earthquakes, chaos... Jesus said these are birth pains, not the end. Don't panic. Don't be deceived. Don't anchor your hope in buildings, governments, or comfort. Anchor it in Christ. When the ground shakes, stand on the Rock. Father, steady our hearts when the world feels unstable. Fix our eyes on what cannot be shaken. Help us reach out and show Your way to others. In Jesus name, amen.

**Tuesday:** (Mark 13:9–13) Jesus promised they would be handed over, misunderstood, even hated. Not exactly a recruitment pitch. But He also promised the Holy Spirit would speak through them. Faithfulness doesn't mean ease ...it means endurance. The one who endures to the end will be saved. Our job isn't to control outcomes, it's to stay loyal. When pressure comes, it reveals what we trust most. Lord, help us endure with courage. When we are pressed, let Christ be what comes out. Keep us faithful to the end. In Jesus, amen.

**Wednesday:** (Mark 13:14–23) The destruction of Jerusalem would come with signs. Clear warnings. Jesus told them to run when they saw it. Sometimes readiness looks like bold standing... sometimes it looks like wise fleeing. Discernment matters. False messiahs would appear, trying to deceive even the elect. Stay grounded in truth. If you don't know His voice, you'll chase every loud one. Scripture anchors us when confusion swirls. God, sharpen our discernment. Guard us from deception. Root us so deeply in Your Word that we recognize Your voice instantly. Block the noise around us. Through Jesus, amen.

**Thursday:** (Mark 13:24–27) Jesus shifts. The second coming won't have evacuation plans. No warning countdown. The Son of Man will come in power and glory. Every eye will see Him. This isn't symbolic...it's sovereign. History is not spiraling out of control; it's moving toward a King returning. That truth brings both urgency and comfort. We don't know the day... but we know Who holds it. King Jesus, keep us living with eternity in view. Let Your promised return shape how we live today. We trust Your timing. In Your name, amen.

**Friday:** (Mark 13:28–31) Jesus uses a fig tree. When leaves sprout, you know summer is near. Learn to read the seasons. The fall of Jerusalem would confirm His words. When Jesus speaks, it happens. Heaven and earth will pass away, but His words never will. That's security. Everything else has an expiration date. His Word doesn't. Build your life there. Lord, help us trust Your Word above every prediction. Let it be our foundation and confidence. In Jesus, amen.

**Saturday:** (Mark 13:32–37) No one knows the day or hour. Not even the angels. So what do we do? Stay alert. Stay ready. The second coming will be sudden, like a master returning at an unexpected time. Faithfulness isn't flashy. It's daily obedience. Keep watch. Not with fear... but with expectation. Live so that if He returned today, you wouldn't scramble, you'd smile. Father, make us watchful and ready. Keep our hearts awake and our lives faithful. May we be found serving when You return. Come, Lord Jesus, Come. In His name I pray, amen.
