**Monday:** Do you ever feel that some people make serving overly complicated? Another problem is when someone desires to help and is placed in an area needed but never trained nor shown how to properly perform at the task. Have you ever seen lots of areas needed to help and you tried to do so but become so overworked and overloaded that you just walk away? HOW DO WE SERVE LIKE THIS?! Lord, help us see the need and ways to serve. In Jesus, amen.

**Tuesday:** This past Sunday we saw the need to be active and committed in attending and worshipping together. We also saw the need to check on those missing in worship. May God truly bless those two commitments. This coming Sunday we see the need to be faithful in service. Check out Matthew 25:14-30.
