Monday: 13 weeks. We have spent 13 weeks exploring how to live a God-Centered life. We dug in to beholding Gods glory and holiness, His eternal and unchanging way, and the fact that God.Is.Love. We have seen the impact we can have on the world around us as we reflect God and His way toward every person with whom we come in contact. We have studied how our salvation, our life, our struggles, our successes, our all is to be all about Him. This Sunday as we finish this series we will check out the importance of protecting the name of God. God is to be the center of all we are. His name truly is wonderful. Father, guide my every move. May I protect Your perfect & holy name. In Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: If our life is to be a God-centered life, then we have GOT to do the best we can to not bring shame on Gods name. If we desire to live a God-centered life, then we have GOT to do the best we can to guard His reputation. Proverbs 22:1 says: "A good name is to be chosen over great wealth; favor is better than silver and gold." Pray we, the followers of Jesus, not destroy our witness or bring shame to the great name of God. Lord, make me to be a lighthouse to draw folks to You instead of push them away. In Jesus, amen.

Wednesday: Growing up in the Bailey household, my mom would tell my brother and I whenever we left the house: "Remember who you are". This was weird to me because if my sugar dropped or anything, my license could remind me of my name. As I became a parent, it became apparent that what she was saying was "remember WHOSE you are". She desired we not bring shame to our family. Imagine if followers of Jesus thought this before engaging in online debates, before cursing that person at the store, before falling for that temptation, etc. O, God, help me not forget Whose I am. In Jesus name, amen.

Thursday: "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain." This verse has been used for years in correcting people who say OMG (for non-text folks, this stand for Oh My God), or when someone curses with the name of God involved. Put your steel toe shoes on because this verse also refers to folks who claim to be followers of God but aren't living this life out loud for all to see. If we claim God, our life should elevate His name. The goal of our existence should be to give honor to Gods name. Lord, forgive me when I don't wear Your name well. I am sorry. Please help me protect Your Holy name. In Jesus name, amen.

Friday: "We are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us (2 Corinthians 5:20)." If people only knew Jesus from the way you talk, work, act, love, live...are they getting a true picture of Him? As ambassadors our duty is to represent, speak on behalf of, uplift and hold high the reputation of our KING. Regardless of our age, gender, shade, status in society our duty is too bring glory and honor to Jesus Christ. Let's represent Him well! Father, thank You for the honor and privilege to call You my Lord and Savior. As I wear the name Christian, help me show You well. In Jesus, amen.
