## **Communion Meditation & Closing Prayer:** Cameron Bailey

**Monday:** Music's powerful. Songs can hype you up, calm you down, make you cry, or take you back twenty years in a matter of seconds. Music shapes our thoughts, emotions, and focus. Psalm 95:1 says, "Come, let's shout joyfully to the Lord." What we fill our hearts and minds with matters. Our youth are listening closely not just to music, but to us. Parents, church family, mentors... we all help shape the soundtrack of their lives. Let's point them toward Jesus together. Lord, guide our hearts and voices toward You. In Jesus, amen.

**Tuesday:** Everybody's following a rhythm somewhere. Culture has a beat. Social media has a beat. Peer pressure has a beat. The question is... to what tune are our youth marching? Romans 12:2 reminds us not to be conformed to this world but transformed by renewing our minds. Youth Sunday reminds us the church isn't just preparing kids for tomorrow... they're the church of today. We must invest in, encourage, and lead them toward Christ with consistency and love. Lord, help us guide the next generation wisely. In Jesus' name, amen.

**Wednesday:** A catchy song can stay stuck in your head all day long. Words matter because repeated words become planted thoughts. That's true spiritually too. Deuteronomy 6 teaches parents to talk about God's truth throughout everyday life — at home, on the road, morning and night. The church was never meant to replace the home... but to help strengthen it. We are teammates in helping young people know Jesus deeply and personally. Let's sing truth loudly through our words and actions. Lord, help our homes and churches echo Your truth. May we do whatever is needed. In Jesus, amen.

**Thursday:** Somebody invested in you. Somebody prayed for you. Somebody taught you Scripture, took you to church, encouraged you, or showed you grace when you messed up. Now it's our turn. First Timothy 4:12 reminds young believers not to let anyone look down on them because of their age. Young people aren't "too young" to worship, serve, lead, or change lives for Jesus. We need them plugged in, encouraged, and growing. The church of tomorrow grows stronger when the church of today pours into them now. Lord, use us to lift up our youth. Let it become our priority through Jesus, amen.

**Friday:** Music can either feed chaos or bring peace. The same is true with the voices we allow into our hearts. Philippians 4:8 tells us to focus on what's true, honorable, just, pure, and worthy of praise. Our youth are surrounded by noise every single day. They need homes and churches where they can hear the steady, loving truth of Jesus. Sometimes reaching them means changing methods without changing the message. We do whatever it takes to point them toward Christ. God, help us reach without compromising truth. In Jesus, amen.

**Saturday:** A good song has harmony... different voices and instruments working together beautifully. That's the picture of the church and family working side by side. Parents teaching at home. The church encouraging and discipling. Youth leaders loving and guiding. Older generations mentoring younger ones. Psalm 145 says one generation will declare God's works to another. That's our mission. Youth Sunday is more than a program... it's a reminder that these young people matter deeply to God. Let's help them hear His voice above every other voice in the world. Lord, unite us in raising up strong followers of Jesus. Remove our thoughts that we only follow You. In Jesus' name, amen.
