KCC Daily Devotion

Monday: Sunday finishes up 35 weeks studying the Gospel of Mark. Everybody loves a happy ending, but Mark 16 reminds us this isn't just a good story...it's a true victory. The tomb is empty. Death didn't win. Sin didn't win. Jesus did. And if He walked out of that grave, then hope is alive for us too. No matter what you're facing, this isn't the end of your story either. God specializes in resurrection. Today, live like the stone is rolled away... because it is. Lord, help me live with resurrection hope every day. In the perfect name of Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: The angel said, "He is not here... He has risen!" Simple words that are world-changing truth. The same power that raised Jesus is still at work today. That means your past doesn't define you, your failures don't own you, your sin doesn't get the final word. Jesus does. Everybody loves a happy ending...but this one transforms every beginning too. Start fresh today. Jesus, remind me that You've already won. Help me walk in that victory. In You, amen.

Wednesday: Mary saw Him. Then two others on the road saw Him. Then the eleven saw Him. Jesus kept showing up...and He still does. Sometimes we miss Him. Sometimes we doubt. But He doesn't stop pursuing. Mark shows us a Savior who meets people right where they are; fearful, confused, even unbelieving. If you're struggling today, don't quit. He's closer than you think. Lord, open my eyes to see You working in my life today. In Jesus name, amen.

Thursday: Jesus gave them a mission: "Go into all the world..." The story didn't end at the empty tomb, it launched a movement. Everybody loves a happy ending, but Jesus calls us into a purposeful middle. We're part of the story now. There are people who need hope, truth, and love. Oh if each one could reach one... imagine what God would do. God, give me boldness to share Your good news today. Help me follow this passage so that as I go...I strive to reach just one more in the perfect name of Jesus. In Him, amen.

Friday: The disciples didn't have it all together... but they went. And as they went, the Lord worked with them. That's the beauty of this mission. You don't go alone. God moves through ordinary people willing to say yes. You don't need perfection, just obedience. Step out in faith today and trust Him to do what only He can do. Father, use me today... work through my words and actions. Empower me to believe I can make a difference. Through Jesus, amen.

Saturday: Mark ends with Jesus ascending and the disciples continuing the mission. It feels like an ending, but it's really a beginning. The Gospel doesn't stop...it keeps going through us. Everybody loves a happy ending... but this is an ongoing victory story. Lives still being changed. Hearts still being saved. So keep striving. Keep loving. Keep reaching one more person. Lord, help me stay faithful to Your mission every day. Explode KCC in Jesus' name, amen.
