KCC Daily Devotion

Monday: Over the next three months we'll slowly walk through the book of Colossians together. Before we dive into the deep truths of this letter, remember this...Paul didn't write because he had all the answers from a distance. He wrote because he loved God's people. This series should help us implement the missions minded mentality into changing hearts. Read Colossians 1:1-2 today. Good God Almighty, prepare my heart to receive Your Word with humility and help us love one another well. In Jesus' name, amen.

Tuesday: Every church has a story. Colossae was a real city filled with real people facing real struggles, yet God chose that place to display His grace. The same is still true today. Our church isn't perfect, but it belongs to Christ, and He is still shaping His people. Read Colossians 1:2 today and thank God for placing us together as a church family. Lord, continue growing us in love, unity, and faithfulness. We say "Be The Good". Help us do just that. In Jesus, amen.

Wednesday: Paul wrote because false ideas were beginning to pull believers attention away from Jesus. The devil still works this way today. If he can't keep us from believing, he'll try distracting us from growing. As we prepare to study Colossians together, let's determine to keep Christ at the center of everything. Read Hebrews 12:2 and ask God to help you fix your eyes on Jesus instead of the noise and distractions surrounding you each day. Father, guide our KCC family. Help us explode like we've done before as we reach out. Place a name of someone close to me on my heart. Help me reach this One. In Jesus, amen.

Thursday: One of the beautiful things about Paul's letters is how personal they feel. He genuinely cared about people enough to encourage them, correct them, pray for them, and continually point them back to Jesus. That's what healthy church families do. We speak truth, but we always do it with love. Read Ephesians 4:15 today and ask God to help us build one another up through loving words and Christlike actions. God, grow KCC. Help us put the missions minded concepts to use. Here we are. Use us, Lord. In Jesus' name, amen.

Friday: This Sunday begins our journey through Colossians, but it's really a journey toward seeing Jesus more clearly. The more we understand who He is, the more we discover who we are because of Him. We don't have to chase what the world promises because Christ is enough. Read Colossians 2:10 today and thank God that your identity, hope, and completeness are found in Jesus alone. Lord, may we never lose sight of Your holy truth. In Jesus, amen.

Saturday: Tomorrow we begin an exciting journey through Colossians together. Before you arrive, remember this...you're loved. God and your church family love you. Our prayer is that everyone who walks through our doors experiences both the truth of God's Word and the love of God's people. Read Romans 15:7 and ask God to help us welcome others just as Christ has welcomed us. Father, we're excited to worship together. Fill Your house up! In Jesus name, amen.
