Monday: Questions are not the enemy of faith. In fact, questions often become the doorway to grow deeper. Thomas doubted the resurrection until he encountered the risen Jesus. Rather than condemning him, Jesus provided what Thomas needed to believe. As we become more missions minded, we must remember that lots of folks around us have honest questions. Instead of avoiding them, let's patiently help them seek the answers found in Christ. Father, help me show grace and patience to those wrestling with questions about You. Help me help them remove all doubt. In Jesus perfect name, amen.

Tuesday: In Mark 9, the father cried out, "I do believe; help my unbelief!" What an honest prayer. Sometimes people want to believe but struggle with doubts and uncertainties. Before we become frustrated, we need to remember that many of us have also had seasons of questions. God's not intimidated by sincere seekers. As followers, we should create an environment where questions can be asked and truth can be discovered. Lord, help me be compassionate toward those who are searching for answers. In Jesus, amen.

Wednesday: Peter tells believers to always be ready to give a reason for the hope that is within them, yet to do this with gentleness and respect. Sharing our faith is not about winning arguments. It's about helping people move beyond barriers to belief. What good is it to win a debate but lose an opportunity. Truth and kindness work best together when pointing people toward Jesus. Father, help me speak truth with gentleness, respect, and love. Guide my actions, attitudes & words to lead others to You. In Jesus, amen.

Thursday: Jesus said, "Ask, and it will be given to you. Seek, and you will find. Knock, and the door will be opened to you." God welcomes sincere seekers. Many people have doubts because they've never taken time to truly seek Him. Others have sought but need someone to walk beside them through the process. As missions-minded followers of Jesus, we can encourage people to keep seeking because God promises they will find Him. Lord, help me encourage others to seek You with all their hearts. In Jesus' name, amen.

Friday: Jeremiah 29:13 contains a wonderful promise: "You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart." God is not hiding from people. He desires to be known. Sometimes doubts remain because people are looking everywhere except toward God. Our role is not to force faith upon anyone but to lovingly point them toward the One who can answer their deepest questions and satisfy their greatest needs. Father, use me to point people toward the truth found in You alone. Through the love of Jesus, amen.

Saturday: Every person has barriers that can stand in the way of faith. For some it's doubt. For others it's hurt, pride, disappointment, or fear. The good news is that God is able to work through His people to help remove those obstacles. This week, pray for open eyes, open hearts, and open conversations. You never know when God may use a simple conversation to help someone take their next step toward Jesus. Good God Almighty, use me to help others move beyond doubt and closer to You. In Jesus' name, amen.
