### **KCC Daily Devotion**

Monday: This weeks section comes from Mark 6:1-13. When Jesus returned to His hometown, those who knew Him best refused to believe in Him. Familiarity blinded them to His power. Sometimes, rejection comes from those closest to us instead of strangers. Yet even in failure, God is shaping our hearts for humility. What looks like rejection is often redirection toward greater purpose. Lord, when others doubt me or dismiss what You're doing, help me stay faithful. Teach me to trust Your plan even when I face rejection. In Jesus amen. **Tuesday**: Jesus "could do no miracle there" because of their unbelief. That verse sounds like failure...but it wasn't His. The people's lack of faith didn't limit His power; it only limited what they received. When our efforts fall short, it doesn't mean we've failed...it means God is teaching us dependence. Father, when I feel limited by circumstances or by others' disbelief, remind me that You're still working. Help me rest in Your strength, not my success. Keep my heart encouraged from the things that try to break me. In Jesus' name, amen. **Wednesday**: Jesus told His disciples that if a town rejected them, they should "shake the dust off their feet." That's not bitterness—it's freedom. God calls us to move forward, not stay stuck in disappointment. Failure becomes final only when we quit. Get up...shake off the dust...keep moving. Lord, teach me to release what's behind me. Help me shake off discouragement and keep walking in Your calling with a clean heart and renewed faith. In Jesus' name, amen. **Thursday**: Every setback Jesus' followers faced became a lesson in perseverance. Failure teaches what comfort never could—dependence on God. Our greatest growth often comes from our weakest moments. When we trust Him, He transforms loss into learning. Father, thank You for using failure to refine me. Help me see lessons instead of losses and strength instead of shame. Let my heart grow wiser through Your grace. In Jesus' name, amen. **Friday**: Despite rejection, Jesus immediately sent the twelve out to preach. heal, and serve. He didn't let failure define the mission. Likewise, God doesn't retire us after a setback. He reassigns us. His call still stands. Lord, give me courage to go again; to serve, speak, and love even after I've stumbled. Use every past failure as fuel for future faithfulness. Through Jesus I pray, amen. **Saturday**: True success isn't applause or results...it's obedience. Jesus showed that faithfulness in the face of failure is victory in God's eyes. When we obey, we succeed, even if the world doesn't notice. Father, help me measure success by obedience, not outcome. May my heart seek Your "well done" above all else. Let every failure point me closer to You. In Jesus' name, amen.
