KCC Daily Devotion

Monday: Life is complex and non-stop rolling, ain't it? The world around us offers so little time or encouragement for quiet, meditation and prayer. While life should be easier than ever before, we find ourselves busier than ever and more stressed than we wish to admit. What shall we do?! Pray. Sounds easy, don't it? As followers of Jesus we have been given this free gift of prayer...and yet we don't use it unless we are strapped, stressed, struggling. That ain't right, and it ain't how we are supposed to live. Prayer is a vital need. It's time we make prayer a priority. Lord, lead us. Guide us. Help us pray. In Jesus name, amen.

Tuesday: Busy, busy, busy. Does this sound like your life? Listen up and answer these questions: Am I busy because I'm vain? Am I busy because I'm undisciplined? Am I busy because I don't want to slow down and actually face the real me? Read this week's section in 1 Timothy 2:1-8. Prayer needs to be a priority in our lives. Only you can make it happen! God, help me let go and be still. Forgive my busyness. Help me embrace Your mandate for a sabbath. In all I am, and in all I do, help me make prayer a priority. In Jesus name, amen.

Wednesday: In Acts 6:4, the followers said they "will devote ourselves to prayer...". Ephesians 6:18 tells us to "pray at all times in the Spirit with every prayer and request, and stay alert with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints." James 4:2 says we don't have because we haven't asked. And, in James 5:16 we see that the prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. In Philippians 4:6-7, Paul basically says to not be anxious about anything, but pray about everything. In case you didn't know...prayer is a big deal. Let's make it the priority it needs to be. Father, help us. In Jesus, amen.

Thursday: Fun fact: There are at least 7 different Greek nouns for "prayer". Seven. Four of them are found in verses 1 & 2 alone (petitions/prayers/intercession/thanksgiving). There's an "old-school" acronym for prayer to help remember the major aspects of prayers: A.C.T.S. (adoration, confession, thanksgiving, supplication). Prayers aren't just for us to say what we want. Our prayers need to give God the praise deserved while confessing our shortcomings, giving thanks for all we have and all He does, and last place is asking for the help in needs. Let's make sure our requests come WAY after the praise deserved, the asking of forgiveness and the thanksgiving for Him being such a Good, Good Father. God, You rock! You are amazing and we can't thank You enough. Forgive me where I fail. Help me shine brightly. In Jesus, amen.

Friday: We sure do talk about prayer a lot, don't we? Have you noticed that pretty much every series we go through, the preacher adds a sermon on prayer? From people praying, to how to pray, for whom to pray, the power of prayer, M.C. Hammer sayin' "We got to pray just to make it today", etc. Guess what: it's THAT important. May we never tire of hearing of prayer. May we apply what we hear. May we make prayer a priority. God, help us live what we hear and claim when it comes to You and Your way and truth. In Jesus name, amen.

Saturday: Want a stronger prayer life? Try this: form a habit of prayer. Set no limit on how often or how long you pray. Pray while driving. Pray while stuck in traffic. Pray while pooping. Pray about everything and everyone. God desires to hear from us. He loves us and answers. He's simply waiting on you to talk. God, help me make prayer a priority in every aspect of my life.
