KCC Daily Devotion

Monday: Next week we check out Colossians 4:2-6 where Paul teaches how to be an effective witness for Jesus. He purposefully starts with prayer. That ain't by accident. Read Colossians 4:2 today: "Devote yourselves to prayer; stay alert in it with thanksgiving." Being an effective witness begins long before we ever open our mouths...it begins on our knees. Pray for people. Pray for opportunities. Pray that God helps you see the opportunities already around you. Lord, open my eyes today. Help me notice the people You've placed around me and prepare my heart to show them Jesus. In His name, amen.

Tuesday: Paul says to "stay alert" in prayer. In other words...PAY ATTENTION! Sometimes we pray for God to use us, then walk right by the opportunities He gives. Somebody needs encouragement. Someone else needs kindness. This person needs to know they matter. Somebody just wants someone willing to listen. Read Colossians 4:2 again today. Who has God put in front of me? Lord, keep me spiritually awake. Help me see ways to love, serve, encourage, and point folks toward You today. In the perfect name of Jesus, amen.

Wednesday: Paul asks the church to pray in Colossians 4:3 for an OPEN DOOR to share Christ. I love this. Sometimes we think witnessing means forcing conversations about Jesus. Paul didn't ask for a battering ram...he asked for an open door! There's a difference. God can create moments where somebody asks questions, shares struggles, becomes willing to listen. Our job is to be ready when the door opens. Lord, open doors for the Gospel and give me enough courage to walk through them when You do. Through Jesus, amen.

Thursday: Read Colossians 4:4 today. Paul wanted to make the Gospel "known as I should." That's important because sharing Jesus doesn't require a theology degree, a pulpit, or knowing all the answer. Sometimes the most powerful witness is simply saying, "Here's what Jesus has done for me." Don't make Jesus more complicated than He needs to be. Speak truth. Speak clearly. Speak from your heart. Lord, help me know what to say and when to say it. Let my life and words clearly point folks toward Jesus. In His name I pray, amen.

Friday: Somebody's watching you. Creepy thought, but it's true! Read Colossians 4:5: "Act wisely toward outsiders, making the most of the time." Our witness isn't just what we SAY about Jesus...it's how we live because of Jesus. How we treat people, how we handle frustration, how we work, forgive, act when things DON'T go our way. People may hear your testimony, but they'll also watch your life. Show them the best sermon. Lord, help the way I live today make Jesus attractive to the people around me. In Jesus' name, amen.

Saturday: "Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt..." Read Colossians 4:6. ALWAYS be gracious. Mmmm. Christians can speak truth and still sound hateful, arrogant, or downright mean. Paul says our words should have some flavor...but grace needs to be the seasoning. Truth doesn't need us to be rude to make it stronger. Ask God to make us effective witnesses who speak truth clearly and love people genuinely. Lord, put grace in my words so folks feel Jesus instead of being pushed away. Through Jesus, amen.
