Monday: One of the greatest truths God offers, and one of our deepest needs... is forgiveness. Atheist, Marghanita Laski, before dying in 1988 said, "What I envy most about you Christians is your forgiveness; I have nobody to forgive me." Heart breaking. What hurts most from her quote is the fact that she was given a life to discover and embrace the loving forgiveness of God...and yet... she never did. This weekend we celebrate the event which brought the beautiful gift of forgiveness to all who accept Jesus as Savior. At the very heart of our faith is the truth of Gods forgiveness. Praise Him for this truth today. Good God Almighty, I can't tell You how much I need You. Thank You for what this coming weekend represents. Thank You for forgiveness in Jesus. In His name, amen.

Tuesday: "There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus (Romans 3:22b-24)." All have sinned. There ain't a one of us who are better than the next. We are all sinners saved by the blood of Jesus. Why aren't we striving to share this saving grace with more people?!
