Monday: Edith Wharton said, "There are two ways of spreading light: to be the candle or the mirror that reflects it." That's truth, church. As we strive to make God the center of all we are, are we striving to show others this way as well? Are we trying to set the example of love to all around us? Are we striving to reach One more person who isn't living for Jesus? Are we inviting folks until we are blue in the face to come join us in worship? Are we investing in the lives around us that they see how much we truly care? Are we sitting around the table to share in food while having the greatest of conversations? Are we striving to be the good needed? O, God, help us to reach the lost here. In Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: The name of Jesus is more powerful than anything. In Jesus name blind can see. Now, by saying "blind can see" we shouldn't automatically jump to physical blindness. The name of Jesus removes spiritual blindness, self-centered blinds, the blindness to hurt and sin around us. We are called to pray in the name of Jesus. Not Mary. Not just an 'amen'.
