KCC Daily Devotion

Monday: “Most people want to be delivered from temptation but would like it to keep in touch.”-Robert Orben. This weeks truth that will set us free is the transforming truth that we can handle temptation. It is possible to overcome temptation...but we tend to be our own worst enemy. This coming Sunday we wish to talk about the reality of temptations while also being the remedy for temptations. Lord, prepare our hearts and guide our ways when it comes to temptations. Help us see the will and the way to overcoming. In Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: “These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings for us, on whom the fulfillment of the ages has come. So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don’t fall! No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it(1 Cor. 10:11-13).” Father, help me when it comes to temptations. In Jesus perfect name, amen.

Wednesday: “When tempted, no one should say, ‘God is tempting me.’ For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire, he is dragged away and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death (James 1:13-15).” We tend to blame God quickly when we struggle. Have we forgotten the enemy we all have? One of the devils best tools is to make us forget he’s there. James directs this perfectly. These aren’t wistful thoughts from a preacher’s study, but these are the painful, difficult realities of life. Lord, help us overcome temptations. Empower us and strengthen us. In Jesus, amen.

Thursday: Temptations strike all of us. They hit us at school, at work, at home, at Walmart, at the ball field. Temptations strike us online, in public, privately. Temptations affect parents, “kids”, leaders, elders, preachers, whether we are single or married. Re-read the passage from yesterday. James doesn’t say IF tempted, but WHEN tempted. We will never not be tempted. We are in a spiritual battle. The stronger we grow in faith the more we will be attacked. O God, help us. This is a reason Church is so important. Surround us with folks who will hold us accountable and pour into us when we are attacked. In Jesus name, amen.

Friday: “So if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don’t fall.” (1 Cor. 10:12). Someone has said, “He who thinks he stands strongly is he who stands wrongly.” Have you ever heard someone say “It couldn’t happen to me”? Yeah...it can, and it will. We need each other in this life. Temptation hits all at different times and different levels. We need each other to hold us up and help us out. Father, thank You for those around me who help me keep walking in faith. Guide our steps. Help us as we help each other. In Jesus name, amen.

Saturday: “For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, ,but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are – yet was without sin. Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need (Heb. 4:15-16).” Jesus was tempted in EVERY way you are. Yet, he never sinned. We do. We fall. We fail. We forget to prepare for the attacks. Lord, help us. Forgive us. Empower us to overcome temptations. In Jesus, amen.
