Monday: As November begins this week and as we have now concluded our series on the "Wisdom of God" through our study of Proverbs, we will be spending the four Sundays of November studying a topic we hit a month ago about finances. While money is a sensitive topic, it's a topic needing to be touched so we can follow Gods desires and live more easily. We will check out the areas of earning money, spending money, borrowing/saving money, and then end with a discussion on our giving. Pray for this series. Pray for our hearts to line up with Gods will. Lord, thank You for keeping it real with us and for allowing us to keep it real with each other. Cover this series. Guide our mind, our heart, our wallet, our time, our treasures, our all. In Jesus name, amen.

Tuesday: Have you ever paid attention to how some churches teach a "prosperity gospel" and tell folks how God desires for everyone to be millionaires? They teach that if you send your money in, then God will bless you and reward you with even more. The more you give the more you'll get is their mantra. Unfortunately...the ones sending money never notice that the ones getting richer and richer are their preachers with their mansions, jets, fancy cars and more. The Bible doesn't teach a prosperity gospel. It does, however, teach how to live a right life without making money and stuff the key to life. God, guide us and help us. Lead us and love us to the right way. In Jesus, amen.

Wednesday: Check out Job 41:11; Haggai 2:8; 1 Corinthians 4:7. These passages (and others) clearly show us the facts that everything belongs to God. While everything is Gods, He distributes things as He has decided. Take an inventory of all you have. From your bank account, to the cash hidden at home...your furniture, vehicle(s), extra items like china, weapons, boats, campers, etc. Do you own more than one home? Everything. Belongs. To. God. Don't get caught feeling it's all yours and that you need more. Most of us probably need to downsize. Lord, help me live for You. In Jesus name, amen.

Thursday: Check out Deuteronomy 8:18; Proverbs 14:23; 1 Thessalonians 4:11-12; 2 Thessalonians 3:6-12; 1 Timothy 5:8. God provides gifts and abilities to everyone. God desires we pay our own bills and take care of ourselves and those under our care. All able bodied/able minded folks are called by God to work and earn a living. It's an injustice to not require folks to work. God, help us get over ourselves. Help us earn our way. Guide our hearts. In Jesus, amen.

Friday: Check our Luke 16:13; Matthew 19:23-24; 1 Timothy 6:9-10. There is a very, very, very dark side to money. Money can become our boss without our even noticing. While money is necessary to live, it can't be allowed to take over. Many a person has gotten hung up in never having enough. Stop! Ecclesiastes 5:10 says, "Whoever loves money never has money enough; whoever loves wealth is never satisfies with his income." Lord, help me be content. Stop me from constantly wanting more. Guide me. Rule me. In Jesus name, amen.

Saturday: In this short series this month, we desire to grow a spiritual perspective on money; Some sense about our cents. God provides the leading and help needed. Pray we listen! Pray we take heed and apply His truth to our finances. Pray we learn to work hard, work well, enjoy the fruit of our labor. God, help us learn dollars and sense this month together.
