Communion Meditation & Closing Prayer: James Williams

Monday: Most folks have heard the phrase “You Are What You Eat”. What if we take this phrase and apply it to our spiritual life? We become what we look, listen too, read, study. We become what we admire most. We begin to dress in the fashion that catches our eye. We can act like/talk like the ones that sound and seem awesome. Psalm 115:8 tells: “Those who make them(idols) are just like them, as are all who trust in them.” With all this being true...why aren't we striving to eat up as much of God as we can? Why do we still struggle to make Him the center of all we are? Lord, help us! Remove us from Your vision and Your mission. Forgive us and build us to be the good needed. In Jesus, amen.

Tuesday: The word “worship” derives from an Old English word meaning “worthship or worthiness”. To worship something is to see worth in that person or object. There is a reciprocal nature to worship, though, where the person or thing we worship shapes and affects us. Over time, we become like the things or individuals we admire. If folks aren't seeing or hearing Jesus by the way we act/talk/love then could it be because He still isn't the center of all we are? In order to shine bright like a diamond we need to stop living in the mud. God move me. Move me to where I place You as the center of all I am. In Jesus name, amen.

Wednesday: “But we all, with unveiled face reflecting as a mirror the glory of the Lord, are transformed into the same image from glory to glory, even as from the Lord the Spirit (2 Corinthians 3:18, ERV).” The English Revised Version here uses the word “reflecting” instead of “looking” or “beholding” as most translations use. The difference? One is reflecting...the other is refracting. We are to behold/look at God and His glory, but shouldn't we also refract/reflect His glory? Shouldn't others see Him and hear Him through us? Lord, please make me invisible that people only see/hear You when I am near. In Jesus name, amen.

Thursday: Here is a verse of scripture needing to be memorized: “Whatever you do, do all to the glory of God (1 Corinthians 10:31).” Whatever you do...not just on Sunday mornings...not just when folks are watching or listening... what.ev.er. you do. Gods plan and calling is for us to be mirrors in HIS hands to reflect HIS goodness, love, mercy onto all with whom we come in contact.

Whether at home, work, school, ball game, practice, gas station, stores of all kinds or wherever you may be...do all things for the glory of God. But why? To reach One more. Oh, God, help me change my ways to shine Your goodness at all times for as many as possible see me reflecting You. In Jesus name, amen.

Friday: God is the sun, and we are the moon. God is the light, and we are the mirrors. God is the power source, and we are to be the conduits. We are to be the diamonds that shine brightly and attract attention to HIM. We do nothing for ourselves! We are to be all-in when it comes to life as we strive to make God the center of all we are. Father, forgive my selfish ways. Forgive me wanting church, life, work, worship all about me and my wants. Please forgive me and make me wholly Yours. I desire to shine brightly Your great love. In Jesus name, amen.

Saturday: Adelaide Pollard wrote the words to an old hymn as she found herself wanting to go to Africa as a missionary but struggling to find the funds. Greatly discouraged, she wrote the following: “Have Thine own way, Lord! Have Thine own way! Thou are the Potter, I am the clay. Mold me and make me after Thy will; While I am waiting, yielded and still.” Lord, hold o'er my being absolute sway... 'til all shall see Christ only always living in me. In Him I pray, amen.
